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
#### Introduction

  - Lack of integration between organisational and ACLs metamodels
  - Ad-hoc MAS ACL design


#### Scope

- Not macro-organisational issues
  - Institutions, norms, organizations, groups, ....
- .... but micro-organisational concepts
  - Roles, interactions
  - Only those features directly pertaining to ACLs
- Extended version:
  - Integration with the e-institution framework of Noriega, Sierra, et al.




### Social layer (I)




## A conference management model Social layer (I)








